

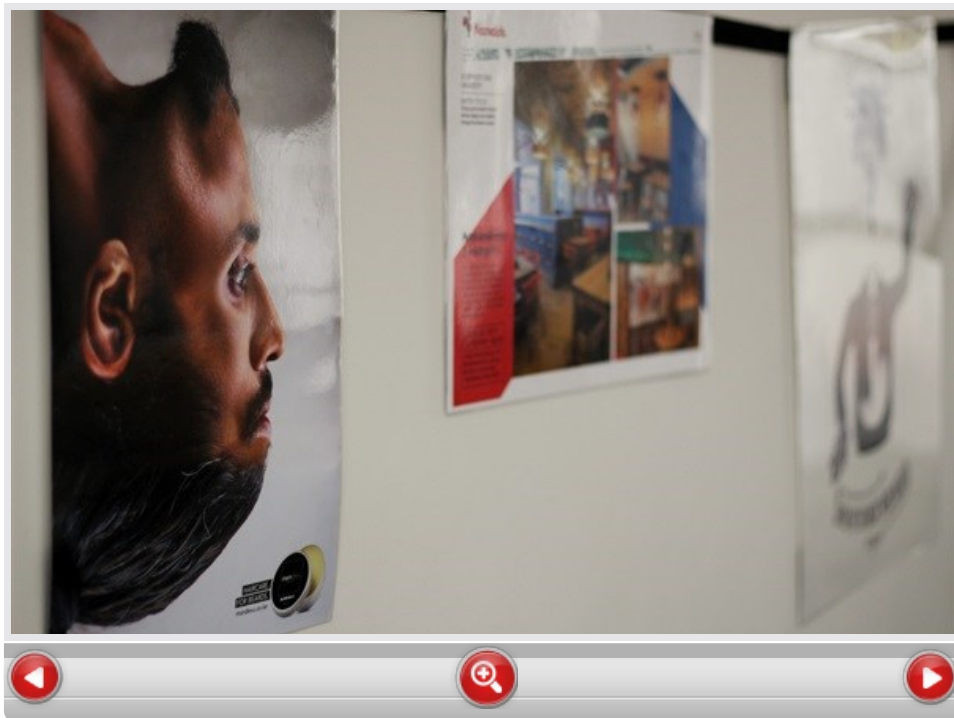
Loeries Travelling Exhibition pops up in PE at Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University
