

eNews channel launches on DStv bouquet in southern Africa

South Africa's first independent 24-hour news service will launch on DStv's premium and compact bouquets in southern Africa.



Namibia, Zimbabwe, Mozambique, Botswana, Lesotho, Swaziland, Zambia and Malawi will be able to receive the eNews channel on DStv (channel 403) from 3 October.

e.tv's chief executive officer, Marcel Golding says, "This is a significant expansion for the eNews Channel into Africa and means that Southern Africa now has access to a new independent news service from the African continent.

"Following the successful launch of the eNews channel in South Africa on 1 June 2008, the news service has grown to be the most watched news channel on the DStv Bouquet. This success shows that Africans want to watch an African-based news service."

The eNews channel provides regional and international news including live reports from across the African continent and world, breaking news, sport, weather, entertainment and financial information.

Respected African journalists Nikiwe Bikitsha, Chris Maroleng, Iman Rapetti, Jeremy Maggs, Macfarlane Moleli and Andrew Barnes host regular shows from studios equipped with the latest technologies like big high-definition plasma touch-screens, robotic cameras and satellite news gathering trucks.

Southern African states with access to the service will now be able to view the following current affairs shows: *Africa 360 Degrees* - a show focusing on African current affairs, and *Playa* - a soccer lifestyle programme looking at the lead-up to the first 2010 FIFA World Cup to be held in Africa. Other shows include *The Showbiz Report* with Nicky Greenwall, *Judge for Yourself* with Denis Davis, *3rd Degree* and *3rd Degree Plus* with Debora Patta and *Inside Out* with Pat Pillai.

Collins Khumalo, President of MultiChoice Africa says, "We are very pleased to be launching the eNews Channel on DStv in southern Africa as it strengthens our news line up and provides subscribers with even more choice and information.
