1. Where do you live, work and play?

I relocated from Johannesburg to Cape Town in 2001 and live in the Blouberg area of the most beautiful city in the world. I am privileged to call it my playground for both work and fun!

I've been a TV presenter for *Expresso Morning Show* on SABC3 for the past seven years, it's a two-and-a-half-hour live lifestyle show. I'm also a radio host on Smile 90.4FM, with my show between 12 and 3pm, with features 'Guess who's coming for lunch' and 'Shape up'.

3. Describe your career so far.

It has been a journey of challenges, growth, in both skill and personality, realisations and, most of all, a ton of fun. I am truly blessed to do what is in line with my personality.

It all comes down to my personality that enables me to resonate with all kinds of people on a human level. I love connecting with people and that has helped me immensely in my line of work.

The modeling and fitness side definitely play a role, too!

8. Who is getting it right in your industry?

Everyone is getting it right in his or her own way; if you can survive and thrive in this industry, you are doing something right.
