How about 'compostable' and 'biodegradable'? What classifies a packaging item to be 'compostable' or 'biodegradable'?



As an example, some materials may enjoy a smaller carbon footprint but require more water or heat to convert, thereby affecting the cradle-to-cradle environmental impact. Being lightweight, durable and flexible, the unique nature of plastics means that it naturally reduces a variety of environmental impacts across resources such as energy, water and greenhouse emissions, compared to its alternatives.

Greenwashing is the act of misleading consumers regarding environmental practices or benefits pertaining to a packaging item or a company's, product or service.
