

# Beyonce's preggy picture is now Instagram's most-liked snap ever

The performing artist took to Instagram late last night South African time to announce that she's expecting twins. Yes, TWINS!

"We would like to share our love and happiness. We have been blessed two times over," she posted on Instagram, signed The Carters.

"We are incredibly grateful that our family will be growing by two, and we thank you for your well wishes."

Beyonce also posted an image of her pregnant self, amidst flowers and beneath a thin, sheer veil. The post has caused quite a stir on the internet.

The snap has seen over 7.3-million likes — that's over a million more than Instagram's previous most-liked post ever taken by Selena Gomez in 2016. If that number isn't impressive, consider the 360,000-strong comments also posted below the image.
